Postpartum Medical Visit Changes Primary Caregiver Quarterly Activity

February 2023



KDHE requires that all primary caregivers enrolled prenatally or postnatally within 30 days of delivery receive a postpartum medical visit within 8 weeks (56) days of delivery. Guidance can be found on the [KS MIECHV DAISEY solutions site](#).

In FY22, Measure 5, postpartum medical care, had 47% missing data. To better understand why data is missing, additional questions have been added to DAISEY.

Updated postpartum medical visit series of questions:

Form: Primary Caregiver Quarterly Activity

Health section (images below):

Q1. Did mom reach 8 weeks postpartum this quarter?

- If "Yes" (Figure 1) = Q2. *Did she receive a postpartum medical visit?
If "Yes" = Q3. *Date of Postpartum medical visit (Figure 2)

Q1. Did mom reach 8 weeks postpartum this quarter?

- If "No" (Figure 3) = Q4. *Reason why postpartum medical visit did not occur.
If "Client Refused" (Figure 5) = Q5. *Client refused (please explain).
If "Other" (Figure 5) = Q6. *Other (please explain).

*These questions will autofill in future quarterly activities. This means you will not need to answer the questions every quarter once answered.
